
Plans are underway to repair or replace as many roads as the budget allows. This year we hope to work on Shippee Road from 73 North past Wolf Hollow Golf Course in addition to the Williams Street, School Street and Leet Street areas. Dayton Street will be widened for truck traffic. We also plan to begin work on some storm drainage projects.

We would like to thank the Lena Economic Development Corporation and the Lena Business & Professional Association for the Lena community sign at the visitor's booth. These improvements will continue to make Lena better, but it's always been the people that make Lena a community. As always, we welcome your input and feedback on our agenda.

The 1% Sales Tax Referendum will start on July 1, 2023. This extra tax money will allow the Village to drastically increase the number of streets that can be repaired over the next five years. The Village is currently working with Fehr-Graham to create a list of streets that have the highest levels of damage. This list will be used to prioritize the street repairs based on need over the upcoming year.

Understanding Your Utility Bill





Current Village of Lena Utility Rates

Water Minimum: \$16.71 Sewer Minimum: \$15.47 Water Rate: \$0.34 per 100 gallons from 1,200 to 15,000 gallons Sewer Rate: \$.059 per 100 gallons from 1,200 to 15,000 gallons

*Each June, rates are subject to an increase according to the Municipal Price Index

What are the charges on my utility bill for?

- Garbage: weekly pick up of trash and recyclables.
- Storm Drain Fee: money collected goes directly to projects related to storm drain infrastructure.
- Capital Improvements Water: money collected goes directly to any projects related to fixing/replacing water mains, waterlines and water infrastructure.
- Capital Improvements Sewer: money collected goes directly to any projects for upgrades to the 30 year old water treatment plant.

Automatic Utility Bill Payments

Save the monthly hassle of writing a check by enrolling in ACH Payments! To enroll, complete the application form found on the Village website on the Forms & Permit Application page at *www.villageoflena.com*. Forms are also available at Village Hall. Turn in the completed form along with a voided check to Village Hall. Once enrolled, your utility bill will have a **PAID** stamp with the date the full amount due will be withdrawn from your bank account. Sidewalk Replacement Program

The Village Board recently voted to double the amount of money dedicated to the Sidewalk Replacement Program from \$10,000 to \$20,000. The refunds are provided on a first come, first served basis. For **residents**, the Village will refund the property owner at a rate of \$3.75 per square foot, which is \$15.00 a running foot. For **businesses**, the Village will share the cost of the sidewalk repair or replacement with the Village covering 60% of the costs, and the property owner covering 40%

The Village of Lena has the following requirements for the Sidewalk Replacement Program. All sidewalks repaired must be **4 inches deep, 4 feet wide, six-bag mix, and wire mesh**. The project must be **pre-approved** by the Streets Department and the specs followed to qualify for reimbursement.

UTV Registration

The 2022 UTV registration stickers will expire on April 30th, 2023. You are required to purchase the 2023 registration sticker prior to May 1st, 2023. Registration stickers can be purchased at Village Hall.

An inspection by the Lena Police Department is required for all newly registered UTVs prior to receiving a registration sticker. The following items are required to pass the inspection to operate a UTV within the Village of Lena:

- Steering Wheel Apparatus
- Seat Belts (each passenger)
- Tires
- Turn signals (front and rear)
- Brakes and Brake lights
- Headlights
- Taillights
- Standard Factory Exhaust
- Red Reflector (rear)
- Slow Moving Vehicle Sign
- Yellow Flashing Light (night operation)

The Village ordinance pertaining to the operation of UTVs will be provided to you at the time of registration. The UTV application and ordinance can be found at *www.villageoflena.com*.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank each of the registered owners for cooperating with the ordinances for the operation of UTVs within the Village.

We haven't had any major problems since passing the ordinance allowing the use of UTVs on Village streets. This is all due to the safe use of UTVs on our roadways by our registered owners.

Spring/Summer Reminders

- The Village Water Department will be flushing hydrants April 17th - April 28th. Please avoid washing clothing while the hydrants are being flushed in your neighborhood as it can cause discoloration.
- Grass length should not exceed 8 inches. Please do not blow grass clippings from mowing into the street. This can cause blockages in the storm sewers during a rain event, thus leading to flooding.
- Residents may haul ONLY grass clippings, brush/branches, yard waste and leaves to their respective areas south of the Village Streets Department Building located on Townline Road.
- As a *COURTESTY SERVICE*, the Village will pick up brush and branches on the 1st and 3rd Mondays starting in April and ending in October. Putting your brush in a container is not required, but helps quicken and streamline the brush pick up process. No yard waste (grass clipping, plants, anything with green vegetation, etc.), root balls, construction material, shrubbery trimmings, wood with foreign objects or thorny bushes will be picked up.
- Definition of Brush: loose branches and twigs generated by trimmed or storm damaged trees. Brush may not exceed 4 inches in diameter or 4 feet in length nor may it exceed the amount of a 44-gallon garbage can. Small pieces can be placed in a bucket or container for quicker and easier pickup.
